UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA

4 June 2022 WINDHOEK

1. We announce one hundred and eighty-six (186) positive cases from one thousand and forty-two (1 042) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, representing a 17.9% positivity ratio. Of these cases, one hundred and sixty-three (163) are new and twenty-three (23) are reinfections. The sex distribution is one hundred and five (105) females of which ninety-one (91) are new and eighty-one (81) males of which seventy-two (72) are new cases. The age ranges from one (1) month to eighty-nine (89) years.

- 2. Cases are reported from eleven (11) regions. Among the confirmed cases, are twenty-one (21) learners from different schools, eleven (11) teacher, eleven (11) students and seven (7) health care workers.
- 3. Five (5) cases have received one (1) dose of COVID-19 vaccine, twenty-six (26) cases are fully vaccinated of which seven (7) have received a booster dose, twenty (20) cases are not eligible, and one hundred and thirty-five (135) cases are not vaccinated.
- 4. One hundred and sixteen (116) cases from three (3) regions have recovered.

5. The number of active cases is two thousand two hundred and sixty-nine (2 269). Eighty-one (81) cases are currently hospitalized in ten (10) regions of which eight (8) are in ICU. Two (2) of the hospitalized cases have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine and two (2) are fully vaccinated. None of the ICU admissions is vaccinated.

- 6. We are reporting one (1) COVID-19-related death. A 38 years old male with known comorbidities from Windhoek district died at a health facility on 3 June 2022. The deceased was not vaccinated.
- 7. By 03 June 2022, a total of **467 443** people aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **32.0%** of the target population (1 471 973). A total of **145 799 have** received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **263 406** adults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **409 205** adults have completed their vaccination, translating to **28.0** % of the target population.
- 8. A total of one hundred and twenty-eight (128) individuals have received component one of the Sputnik V vaccine and seventy-six (76) have received component two of the same vaccine. Hence, a total of two hundred and four (204) doses of Sputnik V were administered. This is included in the grand totals above.
- 9. Twenty-two thousand nine hundred and ninety-seven (22 997) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing 7.5% of the target population (307 298). Of these, eleven thousand five hundred and thirty-five (11 535) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is 490 440 of which 420 740 are fully vaccinated, translating to 24.0% of the total target population (1 779 271).

10. Sixty-seven thousand four hundred and ninety-four (**67 494**) people have received a COVID-19 vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 below.
