**UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL  
SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA**

**6 June 2022**

1. We announce ninety (**90**) positive cases from seven hundred and sixty (**760**) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, representing an 11.8% positivity ratio. Of these positive cases, eighty (80) are new cases and ten (10) are reinfections. The sex distribution is forty-five (45) females of which forty-one (41) are new cases and forty-five (45) males of which thirty-nine (39) are new cases. The age ranges from three (3) months to seventy (70) years.

2. Cases are reported from ten (10) regions. Among the cases, are five (5) learners from different schools, four (4) students, three (3) health care workers, and two (2) students.
3. Twenty-one (21) cases are fully vaccinated of which nine (9) have received a booster dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, four (4) cases are not eligible, and sixty-five (65) cases are not vaccinated.
4. One hundred and eighty-seven (187) cases from four (4) regions have recovered.

5. The number of active cases is two thousand and sixteen (2 016). Seventy-three (73) cases are currently hospitalized in nine (9) regions of which six (6) are in ICU. Four (4) of the hospitalized cases have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine and five (5) are fully vaccinated, and none of the ICU admissions is vaccinated.

6. No death was reported for the period under review.
7. By 5 June 2022, a total of **467 626** people aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **32.0%** of the target population (1 471 973). A total of **145 939** have received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **263 457** adults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **409 396** adults have completed their vaccination, translating to **28.0 %** of the target population.
8. A total of one hundred and twenty-eight (**128**) individuals have received component one of the Sputnik V vaccine and seventy-six (**76**) have received component two of the same vaccine. Hence, a total of two hundred and four (**204**) doses of Sputnik V were administered. This is included in the grand totals above.
9. Twenty-three thousand and twenty-five (**23 025**) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing **7.5%** of the target population (307 298). Of these, eleven thousand five hundred and sixty-eight (**11 568**) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is **490 651** of which **420 964** are fully vaccinated, translating to **24.0%** of the total target population (1 779 271).
10. Sixty-seven thousand seven hundred and thirty-seven (**67 737**) people have received a COVID-19 vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 below.
