**UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL  
SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA**

**10 June 2022**

1. We announce one hundred and thirty-nine (**139**) positive cases from eight hundred and twenty-one (**821**) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, representing a 16.9% positivity ratio. Of these positive cases, one hundred and twenty-two (122) are new cases and seventeen (17) are reinfections. The sex distribution is eighty-three (83) females of which seventy-three (73) are new cases and fifty-six (56) males of which forty-nine (49) are new cases. The age ranges from six (6) years to eighty-two (82) years.

2. Cases are reported from twelve (12) regions. Among the confirmed cases, are eleven (11) learners from different schools, two (2) health care workers, two (2) students, and two (2) teachers.
3. Three (3) cases have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, twenty-one (21) cases are fully vaccinated of which nine (9) have received a booster dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, ten (10) cases are not eligible, and one hundred and five (105) cases are not vaccinated.
4. One hundred and seventeen (117) cases from seven (7) regions have recovered.

5. The number of active cases is one thousand nine hundred and twenty-four (1 924). Fifty-eight (58) cases are hospitalized in nine (9) regions of which seven (7) are in ICU. One (1) of the hospitalized case is fully vaccinated. None of the ICU admissions is vaccinated.

6. We are reporting one (1) death of a 6-month-old male from Swakopmund who died at the health facility on the 7<sup>th</sup> of June 2022. The deceased was not eligible for vaccination.
7. By 9 June 2022, a total of **469 016** people aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **32.0%** of the target population (1 471 973). A total of **146 853** have received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **263 852** adults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **410 705** adults have completed their vaccination, translating to **28.0 %** of the target population.
8. A total of one hundred and twenty-eight (**128**) individuals have received component one of the Sputnik V vaccine and seventy-six (**76**) have received component two of the same vaccine. Hence, a total of two hundred and four (**204**) doses of Sputnik V were administered. This is included in the grand totals above.
9. Twenty-three thousand two hundred and fifty-seven (**23 257**) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing **7.6%** of the target population (307 298). Of these, eleven thousand seven hundred and sixty-seven (**11 767**) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is **492 273** of which **422 472** are fully vaccinated, translating to **24.0%** of the total target population (1 779 271).

10. Sixty-nine thousand two hundred and eighty-two (**69 282**) people have received a COVID-19 vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 below.
