UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA

22 June 2022 WINDHOEK

1. We announce twenty-six (26) positive cases from five hundred and sixty-four (564) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, representing a 4.6% positivity ratio. Of these positive cases, twenty-four (24) are new cases and two (2) are reinfections. The sex distribution is fifteen (15) females of which fourteen (14) are new cases and eleven (11) males of which ten (10) are new cases. The age ranges from five (5) months to eighty-nine (89) years.

- 2. Cases are reported from seven (7) regions. Among the confirmed cases are three (3) learners, two (2) health care workers, and one (1) student.
- 3. One (1) case received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine and ten (10) cases are fully vaccinated of which two (2) cases received a booster dose, three (3) cases are not eligible and twelve (12) cases are not vaccinated.
- 4. One hundred and sixty-one (161) cases from seven (7) regions have recovered.

5. The number of active cases is six hundred and fifty-one (651). Thirty-five (35) cases are currently hospitalized in eleven (11) regions of which two (2) are in ICU. One (1) of the hospitalized case has received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, six (6) are fully vaccinated. None of the ICU admissions is vaccinated.

- 6. No death was reported for the period under review.
- 7. By 21 June 2022, a total of **472 388** people aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **32.1%** of the target population (1 471 973). A total of **149 428 have** received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **264 658** adults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **414 086** adults have completed their vaccination, translating to **28.1 %** of the target population.
- 8. A total of one hundred and twenty-eight (128) individuals have received component one of the Sputnik V vaccines and seventy-six (76) have received component two of the same vaccine. Hence, a total of two hundred and four (204) doses of Sputnik V were administered. This is included in the grand totals above.
- 9. Twenty-three thousand seven hundred and ninety-one (23 791) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing 8.0% of the target population (307 298). Of these, twelve thousand and thirty-six (12 036) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is 496 179 of which 426 122 are fully vaccinated, translating to 24.0% of the total target population (1 779 271).
- 10. Seventy- two thousand eight hundred and eight (**72 808**) people have received a COVID-19 vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 below.

12. Key message

- We are observing fewer cases of new infections, hospitalisation and deaths over the past few days. This may mean that we are gradually exiting the Fifth Wave.
- However, we are still having unvaccinated patients ending up in ICU where some end up loosing their lives. Our records show that 85% of admissions are unvaccinated and 100% of ICU admissions are unvaccinated. What more evidence do we need to persuade us to get vaccinated?
- To those who are complying with public health measures we ask them to continue. Vaccination remains our powerful intervention to bring Covid-19 under control in Namibia. Let us continue to do the right thing.
