UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA

4 July 2022 WINDHOEK

- 1. We announce six (6) positive cases from three hundred and three (303) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, representing a 2.0% positivity ratio. Of these positive cases five (5) are new cases and one (1) is a reinfection. The sex distribution is four (4) females and two (2) males. The age ranges from twenty-eight (28) years old to fifty-four (54) years. All cases are reported from Khomas region.
- 2. Two (2) cases are fully vaccinated and four (4) cases are not vaccinated.
- 3. Fourteen (14) cases from five (5) regions have recovered.

5. The number of active cases is three hundred and fifty-seven (357). Twenty-eight (28) cases are currently hospitalized in ten (10) regions of which three (3) are in ICU. One (1) of the hospitalized cases has received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, one (1) is fully vaccinated, and none of the ICU admissions is vaccinated.

- 6. No death was reported for the period under review.
- 7. By 3 July 2022, a total of **475 749** people aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **32.3%** of the target population (1 471 973). A total of **151 677** have received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **265 730** adults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **417 407** adults have completed their vaccination, translating to **28.4** % of the target population.

- 8. A total of one hundred and twenty-eight (128) individuals have received component one of the Sputnik V vaccines and seventy-six (76) have received component two of the same vaccine. Hence, a total of two hundred and four (204) doses of Sputnik V were administered. This is included in the grand totals above.
- 9. Twenty-four thousand two hundred and ten (24 210) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing 8.0% of the target population (307 298). Of these, twelve thousand two hundred sixty-one (12 261) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is 499 959 of which 429 668 are fully vaccinated, translating to 24.1% of the total target population (1 779 271).
- 10. Seventy- six thousand five hundred and fifty-four (**76 554**) people have received COVID-19 vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 below.
